

INFORMATION CLAUSE

regarding video surveillance installed on the premises of CeMat'70 S.A.

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, OJ EU L 2016.119.1, hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR"), we hereby inform you that:

1. Personal Data Controller

The controller of your personal data is CeMat'70 S.A., with its registered office in Warsaw at ul. Wólczyńska 133, 01-919 Warsaw, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs maintained by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 13th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000067845, REGON: 012030799, NIP: 1180006587, share capital of the Company: PLN 10,500,000.00, fully paid up, hereinafter referred to as "CeMat'70 S.A." or the Personal Data Controller.

2. Data Protection Officer

To enhance the security of your personal data, the Personal Data Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer. The Data Protection Officer is the contact person for all matters related to the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to the processing of personal data by the Personal Data Controller.

3. Purpose and Legal Basis for Data Processing

Your personal data is processed for the purpose of ensuring the safety of individuals, protection of property, and safeguarding confidential information, the disclosure of which could expose the Controller to damage within the area covered by video surveillance. Such processing constitutes the legitimate interest of the Controller pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

4. Recipients of Personal Data

Your personal data may be transferred to recipients such as service providers supplying the Controller with technical and organizational solutions enabling the management of the Controller's organization (in particular companies providing video surveillance services).

5. Transfer of Data Outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries, i.e. outside the European Economic Area.

6. Data Retention Period

The Controller stores your personal data for a period not exceeding 21 days from the date of recording. If video recordings constitute evidence in proceedings or the Controller becomes aware that they may constitute evidence in proceedings, this period shall be extended until the final conclusion of such proceedings.

7. Rights of the Data Subject

You have the following rights:

- the right to request access to your personal data,
- the right to rectification (correction),
- the right to erasure of data,
- the right to restriction of processing,
- the right to data portability,
- the right to object to the processing of your personal data.

To exercise the above rights, please contact the Data Protection Officer using the contact details provided in point 2 above.

8. Right to Lodge a Complaint with a Supervisory Authority

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority responsible for personal data protection, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

9. Supervisory Authority Address

10. Automated Decision-Making

Your personal data is not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
